Objectives

- Students will learn about the 3 main body parts of a bee: head, thorax, abdomen.
- Students will practice naming the senses: sight, touch, taste.
- Students will practice counting.
- Students will learn how to properly behave around bees.

Instructions

- Play the "Lesson 4. All About Bees!" Video Lesson
- **Senses of the Bee:**
 - When talking to students about the senses, you can mention that bees do not have a nose and instead **smell** using their antennae!
 - Bees also do not have ears, but can instead feel **sound**.
- **Legs and Wings:**
 - Students will be able to count to 4 (for number of wings) and up to 6 (for number of legs).
 - Use these numbers to help students do simple addition or subtraction.
- **Behavior Around Bees:**
 - Practice with students how they should behave if a bee lands on them.
 - 1. They should remain calm and take a deep breath.
 - 2. Gently, they should blow on the bee so that it flies away.
 - 3. If it lands on a place they cannot reach, they can kindly ask a classmate to help them.
 - Remind them that bees are gentle creatures and only care about finding flowers.
